

RE: GRADE 10 JOINING INSTRUCTIONS.

A. Requirements on reporting date:

YOU MUST AVAIL:

- i. A Letter from your Junior School HOI to identify you.
- ii. A KNEC Result slip signed and stamped by your former HOI.
- iii. A certified copy of your birth Certificate.

B. Other personal items for own use

- i. Sandals/slippers
- ii. A pairs of black **Toughees** shoes.
- iii. Two blankets
- iv. Two light green bed sheets.
- v. A towel
- vi. A pair of Canvas/rubber shoes for sports
- vii. Plastic basin/ bucket.
- viii. Utensils (cup, plate, spoon and folk) – **NO PLASTIC/STEEL UTENSILS ALLOWED!**
- ix. Enough Toilet paper rolls, soap for bathing and washing clothes, toothpaste and toothbrush, shoe polish and other personal effects.
- x. Mosquito net
- xi. Green bedcover.
- xii. Mattress - “3-inch” (High Density); (Shall be availed at school by local businessmen/women at market price)
- xiii. Enough pens, pencils and erasers.

C. SCHOOL UNIFORM

- i. 2 Light Grey long trousers
- ii. 2 White Badged long sleeved shirts
- iii. 1 Navy Blue Sweater with School Badge
- iv. 1 Maroon tie with School Logo
- v. 2 Pairs of stockings with white/blue strip
- vi. Sky-blue T-shirt and Navy Blue P.E short
- vii. 1 Navy Blue Windbreaker with school badge
- viii. 1 Navy Blue jumper with school badge.
- ix. 1 Navy Blue Tracksuit with School badge.

N/B – For purposes of having school uniform of similar shade and good quality, the school has organized with the local school uniform suppliers to avail our school uniform at the school grounds at market rates on reporting day.

Pocket Money

Pocket money, including fare, should be provided to the student by parents/guardians.

The Parent/Guardian is advised to open a Bank account for the son, and deposit his pocket money, that can be accessed through ATM. Banks such as KCB, Equity Bank and many others, to enable you monitor how your son spends his pocket money.

Give / deposit only a reasonable amount of pocket money – not too much and not too little – a minimum of **Ksh. 500/=**
